Pleasant Mount Welding Inc. provides grants to local schools



Pleasant Mount Welding Inc. is supporting three local schools by providing grants totaling \$65,250 to fund educational programs. Grants were provided through the Educational Improvement Tax Credit program and facilitated by Commonwealth Charitable Management. Carbondale Area School District received a \$20,000 grant to support technology-based programs for students. Funding of \$30,000 was presented to the Forest City Regional School District to support educational technology, after-school programs such as FBLA and a new environmental program for elementary students. Johnson College received \$15,250 in support of the Industry Fast Track Program for high school students and summer camp programs for students in fifth through eighth grades.
